## What is Inspirations 2014?

An annual showcase event dedicated to celebrating young people's achievements in Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) as well as innovation and enterprise.

### Who is it for?

All young people aged **11-19** who wish to come along and showcase either their portfolio work that has been produced as part of GCSE or A Level coursework, STEM clubs or hobbies or any students who have a business idea or prototype will benefit from taking part in Inspirations 2014.

#### When and Where is it?

26th June 2014, 10:00 – 14:30, Yorkshire Air Museum, Elvington, York,

#### What can we expect?

Students will have the opportunity to showcase their STEM project work and ideas. On the day over 80 business representatives acting as 'Judges' will be looking for the best project work, across a wide range of categories and will award around **50** awards at the event.

Through funding we have received from **RBS Youth Enterprise**, we are also inviting aspiring young entrepreneurs to come along with their business ideas or prototypes to 'pitch' to our business representatives – the aim to find the 'project' or 'idea' that has the greatest potential to successfully 'take to market', with more awards and prize money available to celebrate and invest in the best ideas. Also to hand on the day will be our 'Ask the Experts' who will be ready to advise students on the development of ideas.

There will be 'hands on' STEM activities and access to careers information going on throughout the day for students to experience and enjoy. The ever-popular Solar Boat Challenge, which last year attracted over 40 teams, will also take place on the day. **Free** kits are available now to schools who wish to take part.
